

LORENZO QUINN
LEAP OF FAITH
ONE HYDE PARK, LONDON

Leap of Faith was installed in November 2011 at the front of One Hyde Park, a landmark of architecture that is both strikingly modern and entirely in keeping with its setting on Knightsbridge. Like the stylishly conceived apartments behind it, Quinn's work combines contemporaneity with classicism. One Hyde Park's profile and colour palette were carefully composed to echo neighbouring buildings, with fins of patinated bronze copper alloy and glass as the defining material and, visually, Leap of Faith harmonises perfectly with its backdrop. Quinn's meditation on the permanence of stone contrasted with the potential of glass as a metaphor for positive living has a particular appropriateness to this famous Central London site.
