Lorenzo Quinn's recent public art commission features the oversized aluminium hands of a child playing with construction vehicles and figures. Inspired, commissioned and donated by the toy manufacturer BRUDER Spielwaren GmbH + Co. KG to the City of Fuerth, Germany, the 3 metre by 16 metre sculpture refers to the child's immersion in the colourful play-world of building, complete with an excavator, dumpster and life-size toy construction workers.

The artist explains: *'What children do in life is only limited to their imagination, as a child and a toy can do wonders towards developing that imagination – from playing with the ditch digger, to driving one or owning the ditch digger factory one day, who knows, because DREAMS COME TRUE!'*
